### **About Rotary Club of Downtown Sioux Falls**

The Rotary Club of Downtown Sioux Falls is the oldest and largest Rotary Club in South Dakota, and is among the 15 largest Rotary Clubs in the *world*. It was started on July 1, 1915, at the Cataract Hotel by 42 business leaders who wished to have a place to socialize weekly. They were introduced to the new Rotary International organization started by Paul Harris in Chicago in 1905. After realizing they had the same business ethics and standards as Rotary International, they joined Rotary International and formed the "Sioux Falls Rotary Chapter".
